- Tuition Assistance Scholarships are only for attendance at denominationally owned and operated educational institutions.
- The student must apply annually for a scholarship and the scholarship must be approved annually be the Alberta Conference
- The student must be an unmarried dependent of a full-time salaried church employee
- The student must be less than 24 years old, unless in volunteer church service, or there is documented medical evidence for nonattendance
- Assistance is 70% of Tuition and Registration Fees for dormitory students; 35% for non-dormitory students.
- Assistance for professional programs in medicine or dentistry for students who have not completed 4 years of undergraduate studies is based on, and shall not exceed, the normal maximum number of semesters or quarters for an undergraduate degree – e.g. 9 semesters or 13 quarters
- · An additional 2 semesters or 3 quarters may be granted only to complete graduate work necessary to secure teaching credentials
- Tuition Assistance Scholarships are payable only to the school to be attended
- Only one scholarship may be provided per student. If parents are employed at different church entities, each entity is responsible for one-half or as mutually agreed.
- Tuition assistance for attending denominationally owned and operated schools located outside North America may not exceed the
 amount that would be received if attending the student's home college
- Adventist Colleges Abroad (ACA) students may receive tuition assistance based on the cost of tuition at the home campus where they are registered
- Assistance for Canadian schools is in Canadian dollars; US schools in US dollars
