21 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE



The Alberta Conference would like to thank Pastor Frank Johnson for 21 years of dedicated service to Foothills Camp radio 106.3 FM. Frank and his wife Yvonne have been married for 53 years. In a recent interview with Johnson, I learned that his passion for radio began in 1961 while doing some announcing on VOAR in Newfoundland. It was during this same time that he acquired a Federal announcing & operation license for radio from CRTC. The Johnson's have lived a life of service to God's work from teaching in the class-

room, to Caption of the Northern Light (a mission ship that traveled along the coast of BC offering Bible studies to lighthouse operators and coastal communities), to pastor of numerous churches throughout Canada. Some of the areas where Johnson pastored in Alberta include: Edson & the northern district, Edmonton, Leduc, Sherwood Park, Sedgwick, Ryle, Camrose, Peace River and Hobbema. Frank was diagnosed with cancer 13 years ago. His doctor calls him "A Living Miracle" because no one has survived past five years with his type of cancer. This year, as Frank passes the torch of Foothills Camp radio, I pray that God will continue to give him health and strength as he faithfully serves the Lord.
