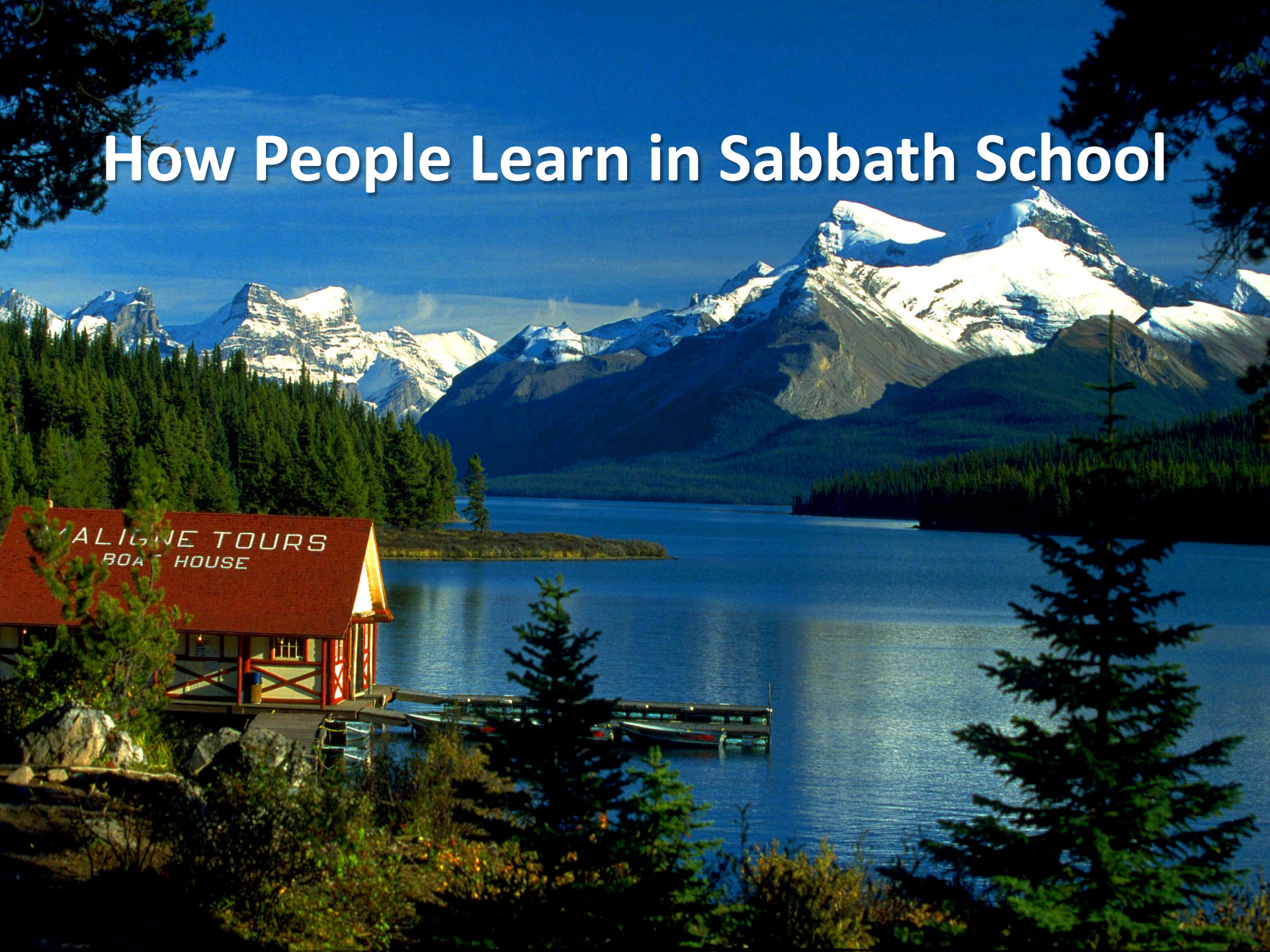


How People Learn in Sabbath School

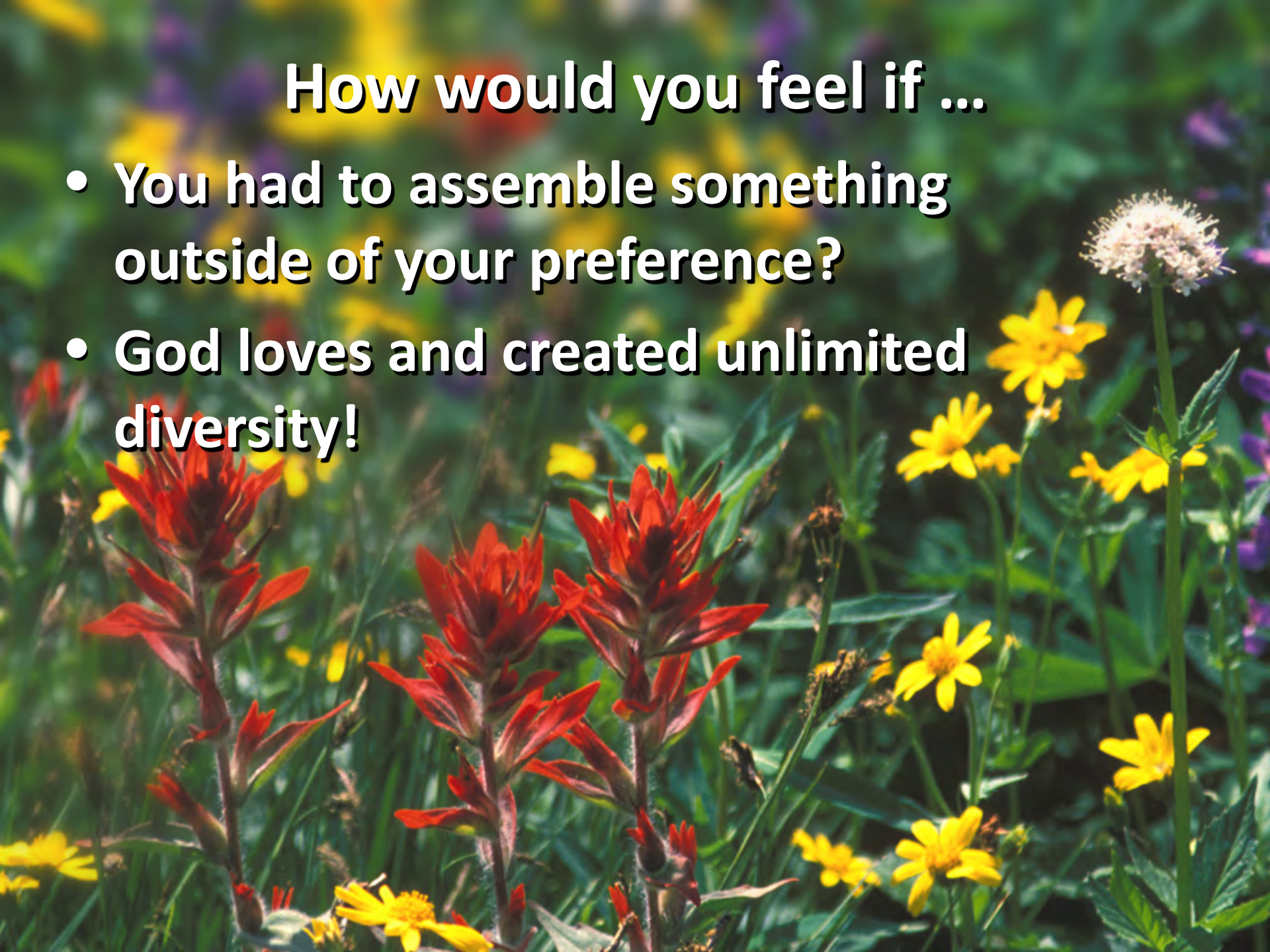
Would you -

- **Social learner**
- **Analytical learner**
- **Relevant learner**
- **Action learner**
- **Which one is right?**



Social learners:



- What can I learn with my friends?
- Desires relationships and having fun.

Social learners:

- Need opportunities to share ideas.
- If time isn't given for fellowship, they soon leave.



Analytical learners:



- What new thing(s) can I learn today?
- Desires facts, knowledge, and new ideas.
- Wants to be challenged intellectually.

Analytical learners:



- Wants the class taught by an expert.
- Doesn't want the teacher interrupted by people less informed.

Relevant learners:

- Is this lesson relevant to me?
- They need to know this almost immediately, or they will mentally block out what you are saying.



Relevant learners:

- These learners are very logical, practical people.
- They really need lesson application!



Action learners

- What else should I be doing (right away)?
- Desires to accomplish a task or achieve a goal.



Action learners

- If a practical application (task) isn't clearly defined, they leave frustrated.
- They need community outreach.



How can one person (group) meet the needs of these different learners?

- Fellowship: (Before, during, and afterwards) will meet the needs of the ***Social learners***.
- Provide new ideas, concisely, to meet the needs of your ***Analytical learners***. Matt 13:52



How can one person (group) meet the needs of these different learners?

- Transition and application meets the needs of the **Relevant learners.**
- Application and local class projects meets the needs of **Action learners.**
